What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following personal information for administering our newsletter communications to you:

- Name
- Email address
- Business Name (if applicable)

Lawful bases and data protection rights

Our lawful basis for the collection and use of your personal information

Our lawful basis for collecting or using personal information for administering our newsletter communications to you is:

(a) **Consent** – we have permission from the person whose information we're collecting or using, after we gave them all the relevant information. You can withdraw your consent by contacting us using the contact information at the top of this notice.

Where we get your personal information from

We will obtain the personal information from you.

How we store your information

We keep this information within a database which is subject to strict security controls to ensure that access is limited to those who need to see it.

How long we keep your personal information for

We will keep your information until you withdraw consent or we no longer send out the newsletter, after which time it will be securely and permanently destroyed.

Who we share your personal information with and why

We will not share your personal information.

How to complain

If you have any concerns about our use of your personal information, you can make a complaint to us using the contact details at the top of this privacy notice.

If you remain unhappy with how we've used your data after raising a complaint with us, you can also complain to the ICO.
