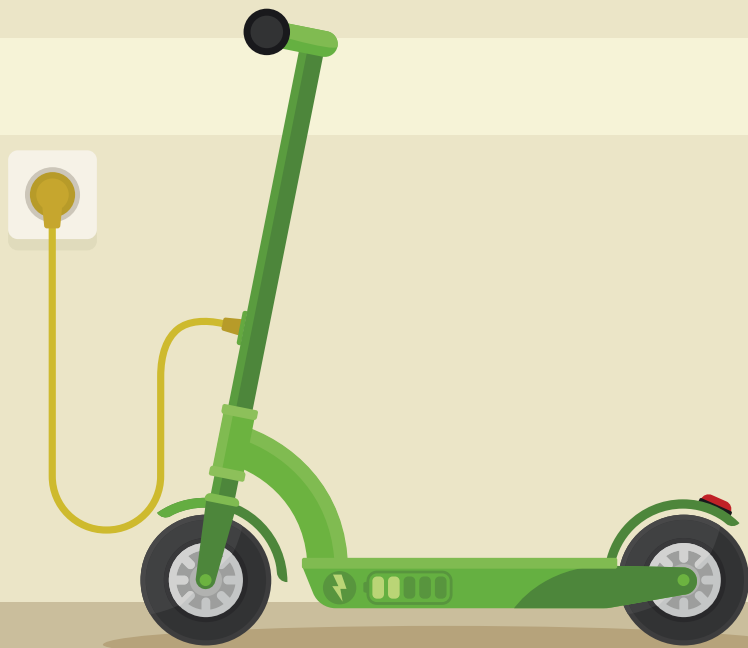

E-scooters and e-bikes can cause fires. Make sure you know how to charge them safely by following our do's and don'ts.

## Do:

- ✓ Buy reputable e-scooters or e-bikes which are certified with a CE or UKCA mark.
- ✓ Use the correct charger for your battery – this will be the charger that came with your e-scooter/e-bike.
- ✓ Use a professional, certified business to carry out e-bike conversions.
- ✓ Disconnect the charging lead once the battery is fully charged.

## Don't:

- ✗ Leave your device charging unattended or when you are asleep.
- ✗ Charge your battery in bedrooms, or hallways where it could block someone's escape route.
- ✗ Charge your battery near to combustible materials.
- ✗ Use extension leads to charge your battery.
